2 27-06-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 379, 411, 413/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

FIR was lodged against unknown person for theft of auto of the informant.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the name of the petitioner has been transpired during investigation on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Kundan and Ajmal. It is further submitted that no incriminating article has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Learned counsel for the State opposes the bail petition of the petitioner.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, in the event of arrest or surrender within six weeks from today, let the petitioner, as named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M.-1, Birpur in connection with Raghapur P.S. case no. 189 of 2022, subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
