The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1(a). To issue a writ of mandamus or any other writ or writs direction or directions commanding upon the respondents for vacating the encroachment made by Respondent No. 7 to 10, who have constructed their huts and Bathan over



Gairmajaraua Aam land which is used as Public Road by the petitioner and public in general due to which has become difficult for the petitioner and villager to come & go from their houses.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the Circle Officer, Madhuban, District-East Champaran, for redressal of his aforesaid grievance. Liberty so sought, is granted.
3. It is needless to state that in case, the petitioner approaches the Circle Officer, Madhuban, District-East Champaran, by filing appropriate petition under the provisions of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956, within a period of four weeks from today, the same shall be considered, in accordance with law and after hearing the affected parties, appropriate orders shall be passed thereon, forthwith.
4. The writ petition stands disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
