ORAL ORDER

4 05-05-2023 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief :-

“(i) This writ application is directed against the arbitrary and illegal action of the respondent authorities, by which the respondents have illegally and arbitrarily hold/ locked the SB A/c. Bearing no. 33175891300 and premature withdrawal of Fixed Deposit A/c. no. 31746037556 for an amount of Rs. 5,00,000/- (Rs. Five lacs) by State Bank of India, Kurji Branch.”

Considering the fact that the petitioner has filed a mis-conceived writ petition and is an accused in a criminal case



lodged by the respondent- Bank pertaining to misappropriation of money and fabrication of forged Fixed Deposit certificates, in which he is absconding, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present writ petition.

Accordingly, the present writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
