ORAL ORDER

2 15-05-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends her arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 30(a) and 41(1) of the Bihar Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a person with clean antecedent and allegation is of recovery of 86.760 liters of liquor from a Scorpio vehicle and 623.760 liters of liquor from house of co-accused Ashok Choudhary.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was not arrested from the spot as such nothing was recovered from her conscious possession, it is next



submitted that she came to be implicated based on secret information which is the easiest way to implicate someone, when admittedly petitioner is a person with clean antecedent.

Learned counsel for the petitioner next submits that petitioner is not the owner of the vehicle and is daughter-in-law of Ashok Choudhary. It is further submitted that the house is a joint family property, as such it cannot be alleged with certainty that it was the petitioner who had kept the liquor in the house or the liquor was kept in the house within the knowledge of the petitioner.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of her arrest or surrender before the learned trial court within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court where the case is pending/successor court in connection



with Sonapur P.S. Case No. 51 of 2023 subject to the
conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
