Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Mufassil P.S. Case No. 831 of 2022, registered for the offence
punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and
Excise (Amendment) Act, 2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and falsely been implicated in this case.
Petitioner has no criminal antecedent. No incriminating article
has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner.
Petitioner is in custody since 05.02.2023.

Learned APP has vehemently opposed the prayer for
bail.

Considering the nature of allegation levelled against



the petitioner, his period of custody and also the fact that he has clean antecedent, this application is allowed.

Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Addl. Sessions Judge cum Exclusive Special Excise Court No. 1, Gaya in connection with Mufassil P.S. Case No. 831 of 2022.
