counsel for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 379, 323 and other allied sections of the Indian Penal Code.

As per the prosecution case, this petitioner made obscene video of informant and sent it on the mobile of Arun Rai brother-in-law (*Bhaisur*) of informant.

It is submitted that both parties are Gotias and due to pattidari dispute this false case has been lodged. No such occurrence as alleged in the FIR has taken place. Petitioner being friend of the husband of informant, he has been falsely implicated in this case. Petitioner claims clean antecedents.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the petitioner above-



named, in the event of his arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate I, Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Rajapakar (Barati OP) P.S. Case No. 420 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
