ORAL ORDER

2 27-06-2023 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence under Sections 406, 420, 379, 120B, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 7 of the Essential Commodities Act.

It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that petitioner has been made accused in this case on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Arun Kumar Kushwaha and Jitendra Kumar, who were apprehended on spot. Save and except confessional statement of co-accused, there is no other material against this petitioner to show his complicity in the aforesaid crime. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent of similar nature.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, let the above named petitioner be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M., Sadar, Motihari, East Champaran in connection with Pipra P.S. Case No. 31 of 2023, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
