A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in Complaint
Case No. 603 of 2022 of Sherghati (Gaya) registered for the
offences punishable under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code
pending in the Court of learned J.M.-1st Class, Sherghati
(Gaya).

Allegation against the petitioner is that he along
with other accused persons has taken thumb impression of the
informant/complainant on some papers and they have got
forged deed executed in their favour without giving any money.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the



petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. He submits that the complainant and her son have virtually cheated the petitioner and have misappropriated his all the consideration amount as mentioned in the sale deed. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para-3 of the bail application.

Learned APP for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail and submits that the petitioner is also involved in the present case.

Considering the facts and circumstances of case, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail. The prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is hereby rejected.
