Sinha learned AAG 7 along side Mr. Rajeev Kumar Sinha, learned AC to AAG 7 for the State; Mr. Neeraj Kumar Singh, learned counsel for Nagar Parishad, Nawada and and Mr. Amlesh Kumar Verma, learned counsel for the respondent no.7.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners informs this Court that the petitioners have already filed a representation dated 01.4.2023 before respondent no.4, the Chief Executive Officer, Nagar Parishad, Nawada with respect to the relief, as prayed for in the present writ petition, challenging the bid process and settlement in favour of respondent no.7.
