2      06-12-2023                      The present writ petition has been filed  
seeking the following reliefs:-

*“1. (i) To issue an appropriate order/s, direction/ s including a writ preferably in the nature of Mandamus commanding and directing upon the Respondents to absorb/ regularize the petitioner on the post of Class-III in the regular or any other suitable post Govt. establishment who had discharged his duty as Instruction under the Non-formal Education scheme till the closure of the scheme in the year 2002 in view of the order*



*dated 11-08-18 passed by the Division Bench of this Hon'ble Court in LPA No. 1489 of 2011 and analogous writ petitions.*

*(ii) For issuance of any appropriate writ/s, rule or direction in the nature of Mandamus, directing the respondents to give similar treat at par with case of other several similar situated persons who had been considered by this Hon'ble Court as well as by the Hon'ble Apex court and their services have been regularized in Class-III post."*

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on account of the subsequent events which have taken place during the interregnum period, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous, hence the same be disposed off.

3. Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed off.
