2 06-12-2023 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

*“1. That this is an application for
issuance of writ in the nature of
Mandamus and/or any other
appropriate writ/writs, order/orders,
direction/directions for commanding
and directing the respondent
authorities (i) for revising the*



pension of the petitioner after revising the salary in light of Departmental Order vide letter no. 81/Jagdishpur dated 25.01.2020 passed by the Executive Engineer (Respondent no. 5), Rural Work Department, Work Division Jagdishpur, Bhojpur with all consequential benefit (ii) To pay all the arrears of Salary, arrears of Pension, arrears of Earned Leave and arrears of Gratuity and (iii) to make all payment with 10% interest."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the respondent-State has submitted, by referring to paragraph No. 10 and 11 of the counter affidavit filed in the present case, that the sanction order for payment of the differential amount on the head of unutilized earned leave has already been issued on 04.07.2022 and then the payment has also been made.

3. The aforesaid factual position is not disputed by the learned counsel for the petitioner, hence he submits that the present writ petition be



disposed off.

4. Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed off.
