Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Mojahidpur P.S. Case No. 127 of 2022, registered for the
offence punishable under Sections 406, 379, 411 of the Indian
Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and falsely been implicated in this case.
Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of
the petitioner. Petitioner is in custody since 23.04.2022.

Learned APP has vehemently opposed the prayer for
bail.

Considering the nature of allegation levelled against
the petitioner, his period of custody, this application is allowed.



Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail after framing of charge, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhagalpur in connection with Mojahidpur P.S. Case No. 127/2022.

This is also subject to the conditions that the petitioner shall mark his presence in Mojahidpur Police Station, District- Bhagalpur on first Sunday of every month, failing which, his bail bonds shall be cancelled by the court below.
