It has been submitted by learned senior counsel for the petitioner that the previous Investigating Officer as well as the present Investigating Officer had submitted a report to the

In this background, petitioner is directed to file representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gaya in the light of order passed in in the case of ***Surendra Singh Vs. State of Bihar and others*** on 09.09.2022 in ***Cr. W.J.C.
