ORAL ORDER

2 17-05-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has antecedent of one case and allegation is of recovery of 15.535 liters of liquor from house of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was not apprehended from the spot as such nothing was recovered from his conscious possession, it is next submitted that police in order to save the real culprit falsely implicated the petitioner even without verifying whether the house from where the alleged recovery was made belongs to the



petitioner or not. The learned counsel asserts and submits that the house from which the liquor was recovered does not belong to the petitioner and he came to be implicated because of his antecedent to save the real culprit.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned trial court within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned trial court where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Chapra Muffasil P.S. Case No. 783 of 2022 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
