seeking the following relief:-

“1.That, the present writ application is being filed for the grant of appropriate writ for selection of the petitioner on the post of police constable, who appeared and cleared all the physical tests after having been successfully cleared written examination, having secured 72 marks in the physical tests, which being the selection marks in the O.B.C. Category, in which the petitioner belongs, but



the authorities concerned have not selected the petitioner. It is further prayed that the present writ application be allowed with cost and cost of litigation.”
