following relief(s):-

*“1.(a) For issuance of a writ in the nature of
Mandamus commanding the respondent to
provide 1st and 2nd ACP, which is due from 1997
and 2009 respectively and further to direct to
provide benefit of six pay revision scale which
has not been given to the petitioner.*

*(b) For issuance of a writ in the nature of
Mandamus commanding the respondent to pay
salary for the month of April, May. June, July-
2013.*

(c) For issuance of a writ direct to pay post



*retiral benefit to the petitioner which is not
being paid reason best known to the authority.”*
