ORAL ORDER

5 02-01-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned A.P.P. for the State and learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Informant.

The petitioner apprehend arrest in connection with Taraiya P.S. Case No. 323 of 2021 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120(b), 380 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that there is old enmity between both the parties. The petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case due to ulterior motive. Further he submits that the dispute between the parties is of civil nature.



Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of A.C.J.M.-I, Saran at Chapra in connection with Taraiya P.S. Case No. 323 of 2021, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
