ORAL ORDER

2 21-09-2023 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following reliefs:-

“1(i). To pay up-to-date statutory interest over the amount of difference of salary amounting of Rs. 10,96,405/- (ten lacs ninety six thousand four hundred and five rupees) of the period 1990 to



31.12.2012, on the basis of pay slip no. 27121309054233 issue by the office of Account General (A & E).

(ii). Penal interest for delayed payment of up-to date statutory interest along with litigation cost.”

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioners to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law including that of filing a suit before the learned Civil Court having competent jurisdiction. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The writ petition stands disposed off as not pressed.
