2 16-05-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 467, 468, 471 and 120B of the Indian Penal Code and under Section 30(a), 32(ii)(iii), 36 and 41(i)(ii) of the Bihar Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has antecedent of two cases and allegation is of recovery of 1261.35 liters of liquor from two pick-up van.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was not arrested from the spot as such nothing was recovered from his conscious possession, it is next submitted that petitioner is not the owner of any of the pick-up van and he came to be implicated based on disclosure made by



apprehended accused Sanjeet in police custody which does not have any evidentiary value. The learned counsel next submits that petitioner because of his antecedent came to be implicated.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned trial court within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Paroo P.S. Case No. 46 of 2023 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
