2 27-09-2023 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following reliefs:-

“1(i).For direction to the respondent authority to cancel the examination of a staff selection commission which was organized on 04-10-2015 in the state of Bihar after enquiry in the matter.

(ii). For direction to the respondent authority to postpone the examination of 3 centres of state of



Bihar which will be scheduled on 22-11-2015.

(iii). For direction to the respondent authorities to arrange the written test of candidate Bihar examination dated 04-10-2015 in all centre situated in Bihar in the interest of Justice.

(iv). For direction to the Respondent authorities to publication / preparation of merit list of student of Bihar on the basis of examination which was conducted by the staff selection commission on 04-10-2015.”

2. The learned counsel for the petitioners fairly submits that with the efflux of time, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous, hence, the present writ petition be disposed off.

3. Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed off.
