ORAL ORDER

2 27-03-2023 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1. That this application is with prayer for issuance of writ in the nature of writ of prohibition or any other appropriate writ, order or direction restraining the respondents from evicting petitioner from his residence/house situated in



Shyamabagh Staff Quarter constructed over plot no. 5684(old)/184(new), before disposal of the connected eviction matter pending before the Circle Officer, Darbhanga and the House-Controller-cum-Sub-Divisional Officer, Darbhanga.”

The learned counsel appearing for the respondents has referred to the counter affidavit filed in the present case on behalf of the respondents no. 6 & 7, more particularly paragraph no. 24 thereof, wherein it has been stated that the encroachers including the petitioner have themselves vacated the encroached premises, hence the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

Accordingly, the present writ petition stands dismissed.
