seeking the following relief:-

*“1. That this is an application for
issuance of an appropriate writ,
order or direction for quashing the
order of the Rail S.P. Katihar
contained in Memo No. 1673 dated
28.07.2011, whereby the petitioner
constable No. 393 has been
awarded punishment of one black
mark which will be equal to
withholding increment of six months
without cumulative effect in*
