*“1. That this writ application is being filed for directing the respondents authorities especially the District Magistrate, Banka (Respondent No. 3) to take a final decision on the application filed by the petitioner for grant of N.P. Bore Revolver/Pistol license, to direct the District Magistrate (Respondent No. 3) to grant an arms license and other relief of reliefs to which the petitioner is found entitled during the*



*course of hearing of the writ application.”*

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks a direction upon the District Arms Magistrate/District Magistrate, Banka to dispose off the pending application of the petitioner, which has been filed for grant of arms license.
