2 15-05-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

Let the defect(s), if any, be removed within a period
of four weeks from today.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Chanan
P.S. Case No. 126 of 2022 registered for the offence under
Section 30(a)(b)(c) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise
(Amendment) Act, 2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is in custody since 22.03.2023 and there is recovery of
30 litres of Mahua liquor from his possession and he has four
criminal antecedents.

Learned APP has vehemently opposed the prayer of
bail.



Considering the period of custody and recovery of liquor from his possession, this application for regular bail is allowed.

Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Addl. District & Sessions Judge-IV-cum-Special Excise Court- 1, Lakhisarai in connection with Chanan P.S. Case No. 126 of 2022.

The petitioner will visit Chanan Police Station on the first Sunday of each month. Any default in appearance at the Police Station would be result in cancellation of bail bond of the petitioner.
