**ORAL ORDER**

3      14-12-2023                      The present writ petition has been filed for removal of encroachment from the ancestral land of petitioner, bearing Khata No. 184, Khesra No. 598 measuring 16 ¼ decimal of land from some anti-social elements.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for redressal of their grievance, the petitioners have filed several



representations before the respondents authorities, but no order has been passed on their representations. Lastly, petitioner no. 1 has filed a representation before the District Magistrate, Patna on 25.11.2022 (Annexure – 4 to the writ application), which is still pending for consideration.

3. In that view of the matter, this writ application is disposed of granting liberty to the petitioners to file a fresh representation before the District Magistrate, Patna / Respondent No. 2 within a period of six weeks from today, who shall dispose of the same, after after hearing the parties, in accordance with law preferably within a period of six months from the date of filing of such representation.

4. With aforesaid direction, the writ application stands disposed of.
