ORAL ORDER

2 10-01-2023 Heard the parties.

The petitioner by way of this writ petition prays for directing the respondents to impose penalty of dismissal upon respondent no. 6 for charge of misconduct and for undesirable character.

This Court finds that the petitioner has a personal grievance and grudge against the respondent no. 6. If he has any complaint it is to be made before the appropriate forum. The writ would not lie for asking the authority to pass punishment order against any Government servant. It is an



exclusive domain of the respondents to take a decision on enquiry matters.

The writ petition by a third person would not lie. It is only a misconceived petition and is, accordingly, dismissed.
