2 30-10-2023 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1(i). For a direction to the concerned Registrar / Registration authority to give permission and direction to execute sale deed for the 95 decimal land, which detail is as follows:

in favour of the petitioner by the Respondent no.9 for which she is legally entitled to the land in question.”

After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law including that of filing a suit before the learned Civil Court having competent jurisdiction. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
