2. Writ petition has been filed for directing the respondent no. 04 to make payment of compensation to the petitioner in lieu of acquisition of khesara no. 806, Khata No. 152 for construction of Chapra-Muzaffarpur new Railway line situated at Pakad, P.S.-Saraiya, District- Muzaffarpur.

3 . In the facts and circumstances of the case , writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to file a representation along with copy of the writ petition before the District land Acquisition Officer , Muzaffarpur (respondent No. 4) within a period of six weeks from today .

4. In the event, such representation is filed by the petitioners respondent No. 4 shall examine the claim of the petitioner and pass a reasoned and speaking order in accordance with law within a further period of three months.
