ORAL ORDER

2 25-05-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail, who is in custody since
25.02.2023 in connection with Jamhaur P.S. Case No. 24 of
2023, F.I.R. dated 16.02.2023 registered for the offence
punishable under Section 392 of IPC and later on Sections 420
and 406 of IPC were added.

The FIR of the occurrence of robbery is against
unknown.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits
that the petitioner has clean antecedent and he has falsely been
implicated in the present case. Petitioner has no concern at all
with the allegation as alleged in the FIR and the same is false



and fabricated and the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged in the FIR and nothing has been recovered from conscious possession or the house of the petitioner. Further submits that the petitioner has no concern at all with the alleged recovery of Cement and the Truck in question and the police, after investigation, submitted chargesheet against the petitioner and the petitioner is in custody since 25.02.2023.

Learned APP for the State has opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid fact, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-III, Aurangabad in connection with Jamhaur P.S. Case No. 24 of 2023, with the following conditions:-

(1) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the Court and shall remain physically present as directed by the Court and on his/her absence on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason, his/her bail bond shall be cancelled by the Court below.

(2) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses, in that case, the prosecution will be at liberty to move



for cancellation of bail.

(3) And, further condition that the court below shall verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioner and in case at any stage, it is found that the petitioner has concealed his criminal antecedent, the court below shall take step for cancellation of bail bond of the petitioner. However, the acceptance of bail bonds in terms of the above-mentioned order shall not be delayed for purpose of or in the name of verification.
