*"That this writ application is being filed for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus or any other writ / writs, direction / directions, order / orders for commanding the respondents, especially, the respondent No.1 to redress the grievance of the petitioner by disposing of her representation or make available the benefits to the parents on account of death of constable in harness due to Malariya."*
