ORAL ORDER

- 2 20-07-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.
2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Section 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition Excise Act, 2018.
3. Prosecution case is that 70 liters of illegal mahua was recovered.
4. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent.
5. Learned counsel for the State opposed the prayer for bail.
6. Considering the facts of the case, in the event of arrest/surrender within six weeks from today, let the petitioner,



above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Excise Court No. 1st Bhojpur at Ara in connection with Agiaon Police Station Case No. 123 of 2022, subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
