2. After some arguments, counsel for the petitioner
seeks permission to withdraw this writ application with liberty
to the petitioner to avail his remedy under Section 3 G(5) of the
National Highway Act, 1956 [Act No. 48 of 1956] as petitioner's
land was acquired under the National Highway Act, 1956 [Act
No. 48 of 1956] and the petitioner is aggrieved from the amount
