ORAL ORDER

5 13-04-2023 In compliance to the earlier order of this Court dated 22.03.2023, the respondent-Bihar State Housing Board has refunded the administrative charges amounting to a sum of Rs. 3500/- to the petitioner, however, the principal amount along with interest has been recalculated and found to be the same, as has been refunded to the petitioner.



In such view of the matter, the learned counsel for the petitioner does not wish to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, for redressal of his subsisting grievances. Liberty so sought is granted.

The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
