ORAL ORDER

2 04-04-2023 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1. That the petitioner, through the present Writ Application, seeks kind indulgence of this Hon'ble Court for issuance of a Writ of Quo-Warranto against the respondents, particularly against the Respondent No.5, who has obtained the job illegally on the manipulated documents in the wrong name i.e. Pradeep Kumar Sinha in place of his original name Pradeep Kumar Singh. In place of title "Sinha", title "Singh" has been manipulated.”



After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioners to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
