counsel for opposite party no.2 and learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Complaint Case No.537(C) of 2021 registered under
Sections 323 and 498(A) of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He submits
that the petitioner is preparing for competitive examination and
is ready to pay Rs.2000/- per month to opposite party no.2. In
