ORAL ORDER

2 10-05-2023 At the outset, the learned Senior counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already filed appeals before the appellate authority bearing Appeals no. 2, 3, 4 and 5 of 2023, which are pending before the learned Collector, Patna, hence, the same be directed to be disposed off, within a stipulated time frame.
