“1. That this is an application for issuance of an appropriate writ(s), order(s), direction(s), directing, the Respondent authorities to consider and further extend the services of the petitioner on the post of Executive Officer in N.I.O.S. in RC, Patna, as similarly situated persons, who were appointed alongwith the petitioner, are still continuing on their respective posts but the petitioner is being debarred on frivolous
