This application is filed for quashing the order dated 26.11.2020 passed by the Court of Learned Additional District Judge-1st, Nawada in connection with Narhat Police Station Case No. 326 of 2018 dated 23.12.2018 registered under Section 147, 149, 341, 323, 504, 506, 307, 436, 427, and 428 of Indian



Penal Code and under Section 3(i)(g), 3(i)(r) of SC/ST Act whereby and whereunder the learned Additional District Judge-1st, Nawada took cognizance against the petitioners along with other under Section 341, 323, 504, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code and 3(i)(r) of SC/ST Act in Special Case No. 2 of 2019 arising out of Narhat Police Station case No. 326 of 2018.
