order dated 08.07.2021 contained
in memo no. 1975 issued by
Engineer-in-Chief RWD, Bihar,
Patna by which the petitioner has*



been debarred from participating in any future tender for the reason that he had not concluded the work assigned to him for construction of Road namely Bgharohi Baarsar to Woraina road which is totally bad and illegal as the said road had already been constructed under a different scheme and further for a direction for a respondent authorities to revoke/cancel the agreement dated 21.01.2021 made between the Executive Engineer, RWD, Work Division Rajauli w.r.t. the abovesaid work and further for a direction for refunding the security deposit and further for any other reliefs for which the petitioner may found entitled to."

2. Grievance of the petitioner is stated to have been redressed in the light of Annexure B to the Counter Affidavit dated 5.6.2023. While re-enlisting petitioner's name with reference to debarment. In the light of later development, the petitioner is at liberty to file detailed representation before the competent authority insofar as remaining relief or the consequential relief in view of Annexure B dated 05.06.2023. If such representation is submitted, the competent authority is hereby directed to redress the same within a period of two months from the date of such representation.

3. Accordingly, the present writ petition stands



disposed off.
