2. The present Writ Petition has been for quashing of the order dated 30.11.2012 passed by Additional Collector, Aurangabad in Demand Appeal No.43 of 2009-10.

3. Learned counsel for the State raised preliminary objection that said appeal has been entertained under the Bihar Land Mutation Act, 2011 (Bihar Act 23 of 2011) and there is a



specific statutory remedy available under the said statute to file revision before the Revisional Authority.
