ORAL ORDER

3 20-01-2023 Let the defects, as pointed out by the office, be removed within four weeks of starting of Court proceeding in physical mode in normal course.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State in virtual Court proceeding.

The petitioners seek bail in a case registered for the offence under Sections 147, 149, 448, 323, 307, 380 and 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

The allegation against the two petitioners is of causing grievous injury to the informant as also beating his family members and snatching the ornaments.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits



that the petitioners have clean antecedent. They have falsely been implicated in the present case. He further submits that there is case and counter case between the parties and the injury report of the injured persons suggests that out of four injuries, three injuries are simple in nature and one injury is grievous in nature and the police, after investigation, submitted chargesheet against the petitioners and the petitioners are in custody since 29.03.2022.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioners.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Chhabilapur P.S. Case No. 19 of 2022 with the following conditions:-

(1) Petitioners shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the Court and shall remain physically present as directed by the Court and on their absence on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason, their bail bonds shall be cancelled by the Court below.



(2) If the petitioners tamper with the evidence or the witnesses, in that case, the prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail.

And, further condition that the court below shall verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioners and in case at any stage, it is found that the petitioners have concealed their criminal antecedents, the court below shall take step for cancellation of bail bond of the petitioners. However, the acceptance of bail bonds in terms of the above-mentioned order shall not be delayed for purpose of or in the name of verification.
