The writ proceedings, in the nature of Public Interest Litigation (for brevity, **PIL**) was initiated raising an issue regarding viability of the railway loop line, Patna – Digha Section on which passengers train service (DEMU) was started. The proceedings also questioned the financial viability of this train service.

2 During the proceedings of the instant PIL, a road has been constructed from R-Block to Digha, in place of the earlier



railway line, which today, is known as Atal Path. The proceedings, with respect to the train service, have, thus, become infructuous.

3 This writ petition is, accordingly, dismissed as infructuous.
