2 07-12-2023 1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief(s):-

“1(i) For adding work experience in total marks in the appointment of Junior Engineer, Civil.

(ii) To consider the appointment of the petitioner for the post of Junior Engineer, Civil on the basis of payment certificates which has been supplied by Bihar Education Project, Bhojpur on 9.7.2021.

(iii) To consider the appointment of the petitioner to the post of Junior Engineer (Civil) on the basis of the bank statement which was



already filed with the respondent concern.

(iv) To keep reserve one post of Junior Engineer (Civil) for the petitioner till the disposal of the writ petition.”
