2. Petitioner is aggrieved for non-payment of due interest on account of delay in making payment of retiral benefits to the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid grievance of the petitioner, respondent no.5 (the Chief Executive Officer-cum-Deputy Development Commissioner, Gaya) is directed to ensure payment of interest from the date the petitioner was entitled for payment of retiral dues till the date the same has been paid to the petitioner, in accordance with law laid down by the Hon'ble



Apex Court in the case of *State of Kerala V. M.Padmanabhan Nair* reported in *(1985) 1 SCC 429* and *D.D.Tewari V. Uttar Haryana Bijli* reported in *(2014) 8 SCC 894*.
