2 24-05-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in anticipation of his arrest in
a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 272,
273 of the I.P.C. and Section 30(a) of the Excise Act, 2016.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is a person with clean antecedent and the allegation is
of recovery of 55 litres of liquor from the house of accused
persons.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner was not arrested from the spot, as such, nothing was
recovered from his conscious possession. It is next submitted
that police falsely implicated the petitioner by alleging that the
recovery was made from the house of the petitioner also, but it



is asserted and submitted that the house does not belong to the petitioner. It is also submitted that it appears that in order to save the real culprit, the petitioner has been implicated, when admittedly petitioner is a person with clean antecedent.

Learned A.P.P. opposes the bail application.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner, above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks, is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail-bonds in the sum of Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Excise Court No.1, Siwan in connection with Mahrajganj P. S. Case No.03 of 2023, subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

The application stands allowed.
