2      28-03-2023      The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following reliefs:-

*"(1) The Hon'ble Court may be pleased to direct the respondents restraining from initiating or deciding Revenue Proceedings during the pendency of Title Appeal No.47 of 2011 by issuance of appropriate Writ/direction .*

*(11) That the Hon'ble Court may be further pleased to hold and direct that the finding in the Civil Suit/Appeal shall be binding on all the*



*parties and result in revenue proceedings will be subject to the decision in the Civil Case.*

*(111) That there should not be any multiplicity of proceedings."*
