2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have sent a reminder dated 27.04.2023 for re-writing their Jamabandi appertaining to Jamabandi Nos. 196 and 201 (Annexure-P/9 to the writ petition) before the respondent authorities.
