ORAL ORDER

3 24-02-2023 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the
following reliefs :-

*“ (i) To direct the respondent authority not to
make construction of Park under the Chief
Minister urban Development Scheme over
the private land of the petitioner, having
description Municipal Plot No. 739
appertaining to Khata No. 105, Total area
one Katha situated in ward no. 45 (New
ward no. 56, Circle no. 85, Thana no. 11 and
Tauzi no. 203, located in front of the gate of*



T.B. Hospital, near Nalanda Medical College and Hospital.

(ii) To direct the respondents authority to hand over the possession of the said land to the petitioner, as the respondent authorities have illegally occupied the private land of the petitioner besides others.

(iii) To direct the respondent authority to make removal of unauthorized construction and to bring the land of the petitioner to it's original feature.”

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to agitate her grievances before the respondent authorities. Liberty so sought, is granted.

The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
