ORAL ORDER

2 30-11-2023 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following reliefs:-

"1.(i) Issuance of a direction, order or writ including writ in the nature of Mandamus commanding the concerned respondents authorities to appoint the petitioners on the appropriate posts pursuant to Advertisement No. 01/2019 in view of the fact that the petitioners after being



qualified in the Mains written examination duly passed the Physical Evaluation Test and have also obtained more marks than the cut-off marks in their category but still the name of the petitioners has not been included in the final list of the selected candidates published by the Bihar Police Sub-Ordinate Service Commission (hereinafter referred as the B.P.S.S.C).

(ii) Issuance of a direction, order or writ including writ in the nature of Mandamus commanding the concerned respondent authorities to provide the answer sheet of the petitioners for securing the transparency of the B.P.S.S.C, in checking the answer sheet of the petitioners.

(iii) Issuance of a direction, order or writ including writ in the nature of Mandamus commanding the concerned respondent authorities to clarify why the petitioners were not appointed on the appropriate post even after being declared qualified but not selected. Although the petitioners belong from Extremely Backward Class.

(iv) Issuance of a direction, order or writ including writ in the nature of Mandamus for constituting and



enquiry team who could find out irregularities in the appointment of the candidates in the exam held by the B.P.S.S.C under the advertisement no. 01/2019 dated 22-08-2019.

(v) Issuance of a direction, order or writ including writ in the nature of Mandamus commanding the concerned respondent authorities for the appointment of the petitioners on the appropriate post on the basis of marks obtained by them in the examination held by the B.P.S.S.C."

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioners to approach the respondents authorities for redressal of their aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
3. The present writ petition stands disposed off as not pressed.
