2 28-11-2023 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1. That this writ application is being filed for issuance of writ in nature of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order for direction commanding the Respondents to implement the order dated 11.10.2022 passed by District Programme Officer, Rohtas, Sasaram in Appeal Vaad Sankhya- 2020 (Smt. Bimla Devi wife of Sri Ramsumer Singh, Village Padariya, Ward no.03, Thana -Baghaila, Prakhand-Rajpur,



District- Rohtas.. Appellants. V/S Smt. Gayatri Kumari wife of Sri Rambharosa Gupta, Gram Padaria, Ward no.08, Kendra Sankhya-66, Thana -Baghaila, Prakhand Rajpur, District- Rohtas.. Opposite Party) and other relief/reliefs which deemed to be entitled.”

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
